Take part in an online survey to develop a preconception care pathway for women with epilepsy?

We are a team of researchers at The Walton Centre NHS Foundation Trust and the University of Liverpool, developing a preconception care pathway for women with epilepsy. This study will be used to:

- identify essential support (interventions)
- develop a pathway of stages for stepping in to support women, and
- develop a patient-reported outcome to measure impact in service and future research

What will it involve?

Taking part will involve completing two online surveys. In this study's first stage, we spoke with women with epilepsy and their partners and family to develop this online survey. Taking part will involve:

- Completing the online survey at two time points over the next few months. The survey will take approximately 20 minutes to complete
- You will need to register on the survey site, answer a few questions about yourself, and provide your email address
- We will send you an email with a link to complete the first survey, and then another email 1-2 months later to complete the second survey

Eligibility

This study will invite 'experts' to give their views. For this study, experts are:

- People with personal experience of living with epilepsy
- Health professionals (including primary care, secondary care and tertiary care, allied health professionals, and healthcare commissioners)
- Members of voluntary organisations supporting people living with epilepsy and supporting preconception care
- Researchers who work in the field of preconception care
