We are writing in response to your request submitted under the Freedom of Information Act, received in this office on 12th October 2022.

Your request was as follows:

- During the last financial year how many nurses, doctors or AHP have been recruited internationally via an agency?

The WCFT has recruited 22 international nurses.

- How much spend has been used for international recruitment?

Financial year 22/23 £124,037 (This covers YTD from 01/04/22 to 30/09/22).

- What agencies do you currently use for international recruitment?

The WCFT has used NHSPIntl to recruit permanent/international nurses.

- How did the trust engage with these agencies (direct award, Call off agreement, Mini tender)?

Direct award.

- How many vacancies do the Trust have for nurses, doctors and AHPs?

Vacancies below are as of Sept 22

RGN - 29.27 WTE

AHP - 4.57 WTE

Snr Medical (Consultants) - 5.41 WTE
